1. Enter Export Date

Enter the date you would like to run the QuickBooks export for. AlarmBiller will export all information prior to this date. Once these items are exported they will be “flagged” to not export again. For example, if you set an export date for 10/31/14, AlarmBiller will export all items you have entered until 10/31/14. If you set your next export date to 1/31/15, then AlarmBiller will export all items from 10/31/14 to 1/31/15 and will not overwrite any items entered before 10/31/14.

2. Export

Click “Export” in the upper right corner to schedule the export date.

3. Download Batch Exports

Once the export date occurs, AlarmBiller will create an IIF file of your data. Click the download button on the right side of the screen next to the data you would like to download to save this IFF file to your documents. From here, open QuickBooks and import the file. You can now run your financials in QuickBooks up to the export date you chose.
